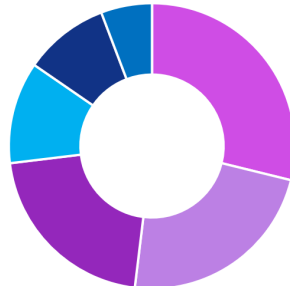

Our clients' countries of origin include El Salvador, Honduras, Guatemala, Mexico, Cameroon, Nicaragua, Bolivia, Egypt, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, the Dominican Republic, China, Nigeria, the Ivory Coast, and Peru.

In 2019, our clinics drew individuals from 41 countries.



Client Eligibility for Relief:

51% of clinic attendees were eligible for asylum, 17% for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status, 15% for a U visa, 10% for a family-based petition, 5% for VAWA, 3% for withholding of removal and 3% for a T visa.
